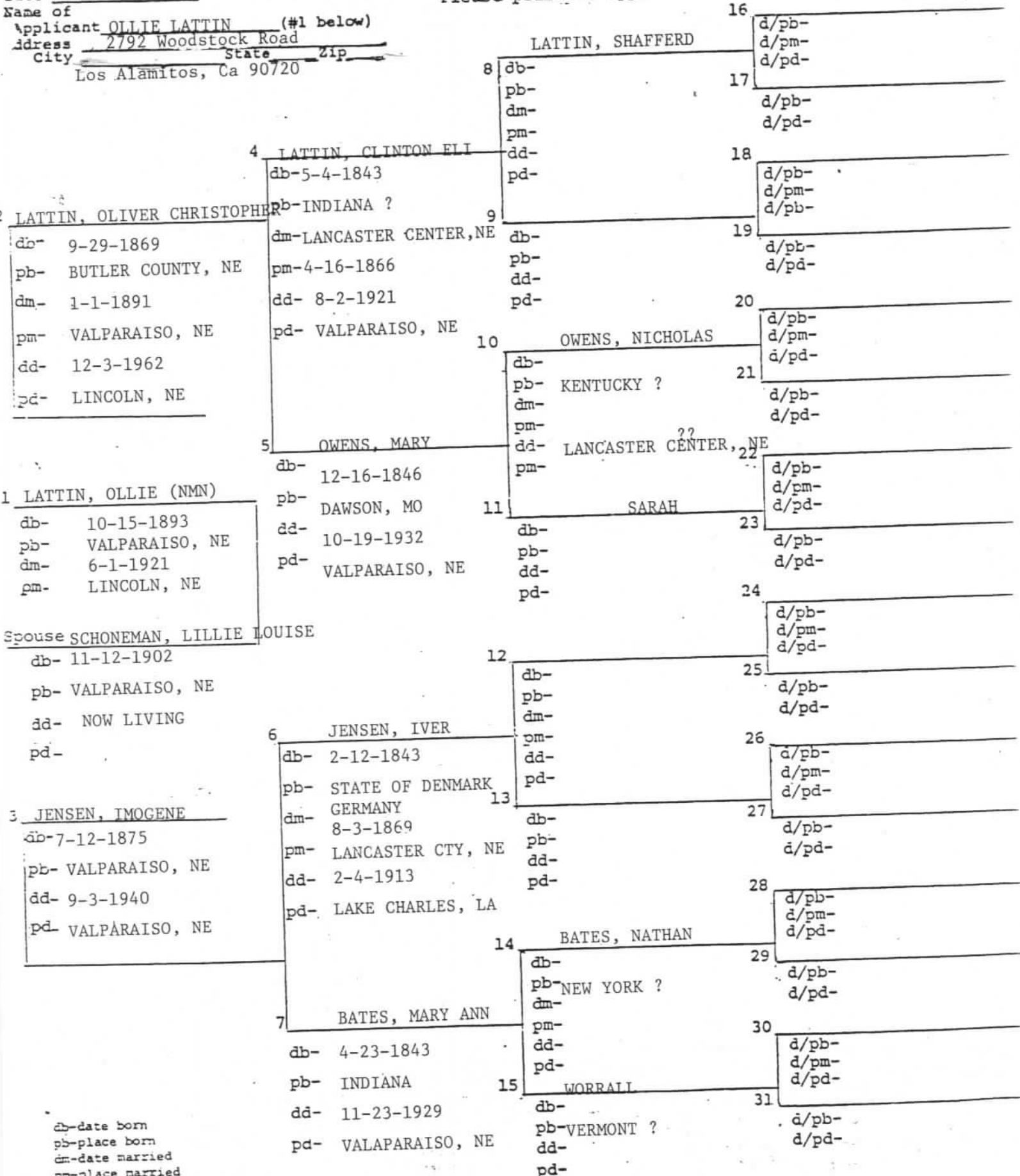

BATES, MARY ANN

MARRIAGES, IF ANY:

MARY ANN (BATES) NICHELSON, _____, JENSEN, HANSEN WAS MARRIED FIRST TO FRANCIS A. NICHELSON IN ILLINOIS. HE DID NOT RETURN FROM THE CIVIL WAR. THEY HAD TWO CHILDREN CHARLES AND SARA JANE. SHE ARRIVED IN VALPARAISO, NEBRASKA IN 1866 BUT SHE HAD A CHILD MALINDA (CALLED LYNN) HOWELL IN BETWEEN ILLINOIS & NEBRASKA AND THIS TIME IN BETWEEN IS STILL A PUZZLE. THE INFANT BURIED IN THE CEMETERY IN NORTH VALPARAISO READS INFANT DAUGHTER OF I & M JENSEN BUT WAS BURIED BEFORE THEY WERE MARRIED. SHE MARRIED HANSEN IN HER LATE YEARS IN LOUISIANA BUT HE DIED SOON AFTER. BECAUSE OF THIS I HAD AN AWFUL TIME FINDING HER DEATH CERTIFICATE LAST YEAR IN LINCOLN.

SHE TOLD MY MOTHER "LILLIAN LATTIN" THAT AFTER THE WAR AND NO MONEY FOR HERSELF OR THE CHILDREN SHE HAD TO SHEAR SHEEP AT 25¢/HEAD AND FINALLY MET LYNN'S FATHER BUT HE BEAT HER AND SHE FINALLY RAN AWAY FROM HIM. WHEN SHE ARRIVED IN VALPARAISO SHE COOKED FOR ALL THE MEN THAT WERE PUTTING IN THE RAILROAD TRACKS THRU VALPARAISO.

THE 18 PAGES OF RECORDS FROM THE WAR DEPARTMENT DID NOT SHOW HER MARRIED TO THE SECOND MAN NOR DOES HER MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE.

IVER JENSEN ARRIVED IN U.S.A. IN 1864 AND SIGNED UP WITH CO B, 13 REGIMENT, N.Y. CAVALRY VOLUNTEERS ON 12-14-1864 (THE SAME YEAR) AND COULD NOT EVEN SPEAK ENGLISH. HIS FIRST PAPERS LISTED HIM AS EVENS YENSON BUT HE WAS MUSTERED OUT 9-21-1865 AT CAMP BARRY D.C. AS EVAR YENSON (WAR DEPT MEMO DTD 4-27-1889). HE WAS IN THE HOSPITAL FOR A FEW MONTHS BECAUSE HE WAS TAKING A NUMBER OF HORSES TO WATER & ONE RARED UP AND FELL ON HIM RUPTURING HIM VERY BADLY AND IT CAUSED HIM MANY PROBLEMS THE BALANCE OF HIS LIFE. IN THE LATE 1800S HE GOT A \$9/MO PENSION. FALL 1865 SHOWS HIM IN TOLEDO, OHIO BUT BY 1866 HE HAD MOVED TO VALPARAISO, NEBRASKA

Winter Season, Fewer Mishaps

Auto Traffic Is Lighter -- Deaths Drop By Half Is Encouraging

Hurrah! Another cause for a Thanksgiving expression. Nebraska only lost twentyone persons in accidents during the past two weeks. Just half the number reported killed in a recent previous period. Another hurrah! The Nebraska State Press Association reports that, in 214 accidents noted, twenty one persons were killed and 220 others were injured, of whom 18 are permanently disabled.

Gunshot accidents resulted in three deaths, four disabilities and five other injuries. There should be an open season for these nervous nimrods who can't tell the difference between a pheasant, a rabbit or a man until after they shoot. Nebraska's hunting casualty list for this season must certainly make Chicago's gangland marksmen feel like a bunch of pikers.

Football resulted in five serious accidents.

Nine out of 25 pedestrians struck by cars were children. This is a substantial improvement over the last report but the ratio of children injured in this manner is still too high. Let's work for a two-week period in Nebraska without one single child being struck by a car.

Here's something else to be more than thankful for. Motor vehicle accidents, their fatalities and injuries for the last two weeks dropped 33 percent. While the total is dropping a new cause, common to the winter months, is creeping in. Skids on slippery streets and highways caused 5 accidents and were probably responsible for several more of the 22 collisions.

What about this for a winter's driving slogan: "Watch your speedometer and your brakes!"

Agriculture has made a record. There has not been a single fatality recorded against it in the last two weeks. This is the first time since the study was started that a general classification has not suffered a single fatality. You farmers, keep out of gas engine belts, don't jump on

Ollie Lathin's Grandfather

William Bays came to Nebraska in the fall of '67 and located in Lancaster County. He moved to Valparaiso in February of 1880 and engaged in the business of stock buyer. He was from Indiana.

Daniel M. Deane built and operated a mill in the spring of 1878, having previously been in the same business at Seward and Raymond, this state. He was a native of Massachusetts.

Joshua P. Gibbons, who started the second store at Valparaiso, was a native of Ireland, came to the United States in 1871; to Kennard, Washington County, Neb., in the fall of 1874; and to Valparaiso at the time of the railroad building, in 1877.

Marsilliat B. Giffin, an Ohioan, came to Nebraska in the autumn of 1867 and located in Newman Precinct, taking up a homestead. He was one of the first settlers in this vicinity. In October, 1881, he came to Oak Creek Precinct.

Iver Jensen came to Nebraska in 1866 and took up a claim in Oak Creek Precinct and settled upon it the following spring. Jensen was born in Denmark on February 12, 1843, came to America in 1864 and immediately enlisted in the war in the Thirtieth New York Cavalry; he was wounded in the Maryland campaign. (?) Rodney K. Johnson came to Nebraska in September, 1865, and took up a homestead where the present Town of Valparaiso stands. In the spring of 1866 he started farming and in the fall of 1869 opened a general merchandise store which, as mentioned before, was the first in the new village. Mr. Johnson served in the Civil war as a member of Company E, Fifth Wisconsin Volunteer Infantry, was mustered out as second lieutenant, having participated in about thirty engagements with the enemy. He was born in Maine on December 13, 1842, and was married October 23, 1870, to Elvira L. Carter of Illinois.

Andrew Johnson was born in Maine on November 9, 1816. He came to Nebraska in October, 1865, and located and took up a homestead the same year on section 22, Oak Creek Precinct, which land joined the present Town of Valparaiso. He was appointed postmaster in 1871, being the first in that capacity.

Charles J. McFarland came to Nebraska in 1871 and in 1877 to Valparaiso, where he started the first hotel. He was a native of Ohio and was a veteran of the Rebellion.
